How to install

- **1)** Locate where you have downloaded this pack and unzip it. Information on how to do this can be found <u>here</u>.
- 2) Go to the location where you have extracted the files from the .zip file.
- 3) Now find the .exe file called 'Class 390 Sound Pack'. Double-click this file.
- **4)** Follow the steps and by the end of the process, the main part of this pack will have installed.
- 5) If you intend to use the included scenario, make sure you have all of the requirements as listed on the product page.
- **6)** To ensure the cab environment sounds as intended in this pack, please make sure that 'EFX' is ticked within your in-game Audio settings.



Bits and Bobs

As well as sounds, some tweaks have been made which are listed below:

- FPS improved by disabling scripting on AI services that are over 2.5 miles away.
- More advanced cab setup which requires you to turn on the master key (Shift+W) and pull out the Driver Reminder Appliance (DRA).
- 1 second delay between train passing over AWS magnet and AWS warning sound occurring. The F3/F4 HUD will show the warning immediately so you must wait 1 second before trying to cancel it.
- Separate key (E) for the foot pedal to reset the Driver Vigilance Device (DVD). Foot pedal no longer linked to the Q key.
- Driver Vigilance Device (DVD) off by default.
- Driver Vigilance Device (DVD) now sounds when the pedal is lifted and the reverser is in forward or reverse.
- Pan Down & Pan Up buttons no longer need to be dragged to be pressed.
- External alarms disabled by default.
- Interior now partially visible from the outside.
